Contains yeast culture to help stabilize rumen fermentation and help the rumen recuperate and regenerate for the next lactation.

Provides daily trace mineral and vitamin needs including vitamins A, D3, E and B complex.

100% of selenium is derived from selenium yeast.

Feeding rate: Dry cows = 6 ounces per cow per day.
